

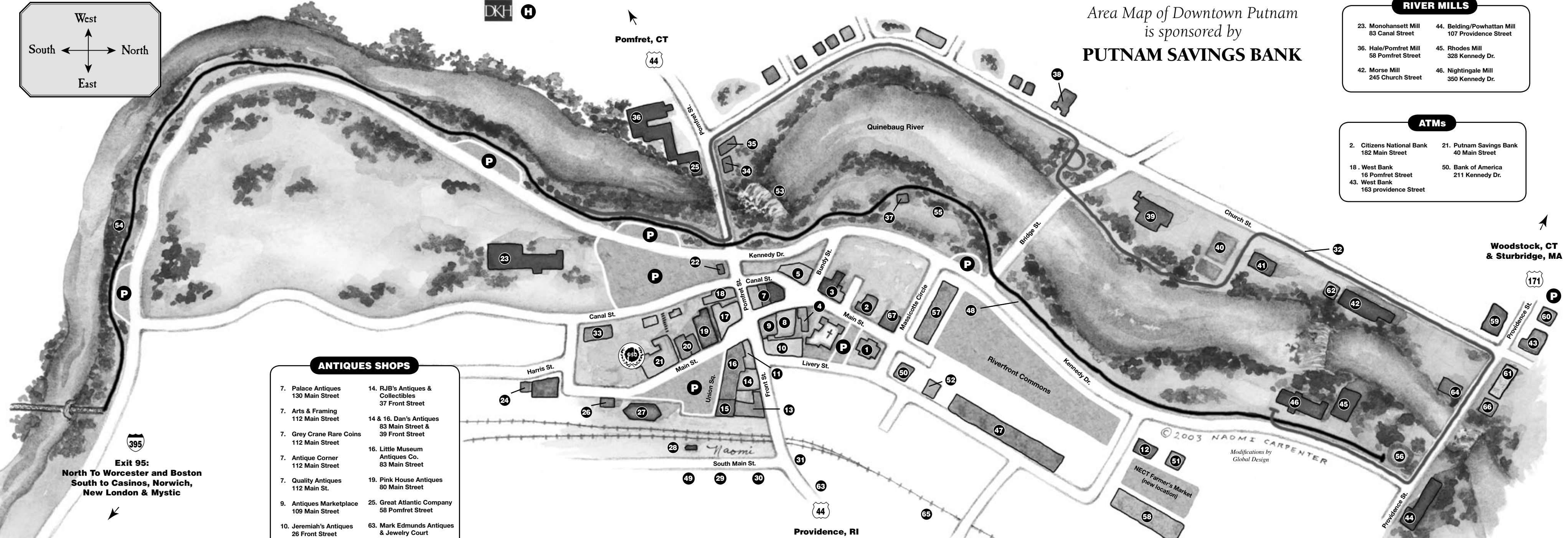
Area Map of Downtown Putnam
